Her mother Astrid Steverlynck represented Argentina in alpine skiing at the Olympic Winter Games in 1988 and 1992, as well as her aunt Francisca Steverlynck who competed at the 1994 Games and her grandmother Maria Schweizer who competed at the 1960 and 1964 Games.
