Other information	<p>SURPRISE OLYMPIC CHAMPION A month before the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo he was selected for the French Olympic team as a replacement for teammate Daniel Jerent in individual epee. He had initially been chosen as a reserve for the team event. His individual epee world ranking was 47 at the time of the Games, but he went on to win gold in the event, which was France's first Olympic individual gold medal in fencing since Brice Guyart won men's foil gold in 2004. "The daily routine makes you put your feet back on the ground, which is fortunate. But I go back to training like everyone else, everyone treats me the same way as before. You cannot relax because you have won a title. Now you have a target on your back. It's a double-edged sword - you scare some people but others want to fight you even more because you're an Olympic champion. I want to achieve even more." He later spent six years in New York, NY, United States of America. In 2016, he left his studies at Sacred Heart University in Fairfield, CT, United States of America, to return to France to join the VGA Escrime Saint-Maur club and pursue qualification for the 2020 Olympic Games, where he won individual epee gold. "This allows me to combine sport and work with a part-time contract, working two days a week at the company and the rest working remotely. In our sport in general, we don't earn a living, that's why I'm going to work at EDF."
